2. **BFI agrees to become a member of World Boxing**
  - ◆ The **Boxing Federation of India (BFI)** has agreed to **become a member of World Boxing**, the International Federation established to ensure boxing remains at the heart of the Olympic Movement.
  - ◆ The membership application has been approved by the BFI's General Assembly, and will be ratified by World Boxing's Executive Board.
  
3. **Adani Ports signs 30-year concession pact to operate Tanzania Port Terminal**
  - ◆ Marking its third foray into international ports, **Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone (APSEZ)** will **operate and manage Container Terminal 2 at the Dar es Salaam Port, Tanzania**, through its subsidiary Adani International Ports Holdings Pte Ltd.
  - ◆ The concession agreement for 30 years has been signed with the Tanzania Ports Authority.

- ◆ This initiative aims to familiarize over 4 lakh students with AI in the upcoming academic year, marking a significant step towards enhancing technological education in the state.

## 6. Centre launches new mobile Number Series for Service, Transactional Calls

- ◆ The Centre has introduced a new numbering series, **160xxxxxxx**, for making service or transactional calls, to help citizens easily identify legitimate calls and curb unsolicited voice calls from telemarketers using 10-digit mobile numbers.
- ◆ **Currently, 140xxxxxx series has been allocated to telemarketers for making promotional/service/transactional voice calls.**
- ◆ The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) said in a statement that since the 140xx series is being used extensively for promotional calls, "consumers normally do not respond to such calls, and many important service/transactional calls are missed".

## 7. Tata Motors form subsidiary for Commercial Vehicle

- ◆ **Tata Motors** has announced the formation of a wholly-owned subsidiary for its commercial vehicle business. The owned subsidiary will be called **TML Commercial Vehicle Ltd (TMLCVL)**.
- ◆ TMLCVL is proposed to be incorporated with a paid-up capital of ₹10,00,000 comprising of 5,00,000 equity shares of face value of ₹2 each fully paid-up cash.

## 8. Volvo to issue world's first EV battery passport ahead of EU rules

- ◆ **Volvo Cars** has launched the world's first EV battery passport recording the origins of raw materials, components, recycled content and carbon footprint for its flagship EX90 SUV, which is about to start production.
- ◆ The passport was developed by Volvo (VOLCARb.ST) which is owned by China's Geely (GEELY.UL), in partnership with UK startup Circular.
- ◆ Battery passports will be mandatory for electric vehicles (EVs) sold in the European Union from February 2027 showing the composition of batteries, including the origin of key materials, their carbon footprint and recycled content.

- ◆ A team of teachers and students of the **Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Dharwad**, led by Sudheer Siddapureddy and Ameer Mulla, has developed a fire rescue assistant drone.

- ◆ The unveiling and demonstration of the fire rescue assistant drone was held during the two-day workshop on Drone Design and Autonomous Navigation in Fire Rescue (DDANFR 2024) held at IIT Dharwad.

## 17. 18th Mumbai International Film Festival to be held from June 15-21

- ◆ The **18th edition of the Mumbai International Film Festival (MIFF)** will be held in **Mumbai from June 15 to 21**.
- ◆ The film gala, which showcases non-feature films (documentary, short Fiction and

animation) will be at the FD-NFDC Complex in Mumbai.

- ◆ The 2024 edition will open with the screening of National Geographic's documentary "Billy & Molly: An Otter Love Story".

## 18. Priyanka Jarkiholi youngest tribal woman to win in Lok Sabha

- ◆ **Priyanka Jarkiholi** from Chikkodi became **the youngest tribal woman to enter Parliament from an unreserved seat in Karnataka** since Independence.
- ◆ Priyanka Jarkiholi has defeated incumbent MP and BJP leader Annasaheb Jolle.
- ◆ Priyanka became the first Jarkiholi to ever win a Lok Sabha election.
- ◆ She is the daughter of Satish Jarkiholi, minister of the Public Works Department, Karnataka.

## 19. IIT Kanpur launched UDAAN programme to boost drone startups

- ◆ The **Startup Incubation and Innovation Centre (SIIC) at IIT Kanpur** has joined forces with the Centre of Excellence for Capacity Building, Training, and Design of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles at **IIT Kanpur** (Drone CoE Kanpur), an initiative by the Government of Uttar Pradesh, and **the Drone Federation of India (DFI) to launch the UAV/UAS/Drone Acceleration and Networking (UDAAN) Programme.**
- ◆ This programme promises to be a game-changer for aspiring and promising drone startups in India, providing them with the resources and expertise needed to scale their businesses rapidly.

## 20. Modi clears PM-Kisan 17th instalment

- ◆ The move will benefit more than 93 million farmers by disbursing more than Rs 20,000 crore.

## 21. Centre releases ₹1.39 lakh crore to States

- ◆ The **Union Government** released **over ₹1.39 lakh crore to the States** under the devolution mechanism.
- ◆ Based on the Finance Commission's formula, 41 per cent of the Centre's tax revenue is given to the States through the devolution mechanism.

- ♦ This first ever groundbreaking initiative aims to revolutionize the coal industry by using in-situ coal gasification to convert it into valuable gases such as methane, hydrogen, carbon monoxide, and carbon dioxide.

## 51. UP to establish world's first Asian King Vulture Conservation & Breeding Centre in Maharajganj

- ♦ **Uttar Pradesh government** will establish the **world's first conservation and breeding centre for Asian king vultures or red-headed vultures in Maharajganj.**
- ♦ The facility will improve the population of critically endangered species listed in the International Union for Conservation of Nature's red list since 2007.
- ♦ The centre is named Jatayu Conservation and Breeding Centre.

## 52. JP Nadda launches National STOP Diarrhoea Campaign 2024

- ♦ **Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare Jagat Prakash Nadda** has launched the **National STOP Diarrhoea Campaign 2024** at a function in New Delhi.
- ♦ He launched the campaign by distributing oral rehydration salts (ORS) and zinc tablets to children in presence of Minister of States for Health Anupriya Patel and Patraprao Jadhav.

## 53. Jitendra Singh launches 'One Week One Theme' Campaign

- ♦ **Dr. Jitendra Singh** has launched "**One Week One Theme**" (OWOT) campaign showcasing recent success stories of India in different streams of science and technology.
- ♦ 'One week One Theme' is the brainchild of Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh. 'OWOT' is built on the legacy and success of the 'One Week One Lab' (OWOL) initiative started last year.

## 54. Srinagar gets tag of 'World Craft City', fourth from country

- ♦ **Srinagar** has become the fourth Indian city to be **recognised as a 'World Craft City' by the World Craft Council (WCC)**, three years after it was designated as part of the UNESCO Creative City Network (UCCN) for crafts and folk arts.
- ♦ Jaipur, Malappuram and Mysore are the other Indian cities that have previously been recognised as World Craft Cities.

## 55. &T win deals for 185 MW solar plant in Bihar

- ♦ **Larsen & Toubro (L&T)** has secured a major order for **setting up a grid-connected 185 megawatt (MW) solar PV plant along with a 254 MWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) at Kajra in Lakhisarai district of Bihar.**
- ♦ The project cost is estimated to be in the range of ₹2,500-5,000 crore.
- ♦ In addition, the BESS will also help smooth the fluctuations in generation, frequency regulation and voltage support. It comes with a black start capability to the grid that will facilitate quick re-energization after an outage.

## 56. Kerala's Kozhikode becomes India's first UNESCO 'City of Literature'

- ♦ **Kozhikode in north Kerala**, known for its rich cultural heritage, was officially declared as India's first UNESCO 'City of Literature'.

- ◆ The state government also announced that from coming year, June 23 will be celebrated as the 'City of Literature' Day of Kozhikode.
- ◆ In October 2023, Kozhikode had earned a place in the 'Literature' category of the UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN).

## 57. Mazagaon Dock Shipbuilders get Navratna status as 18th PSU

- ◆ **Mazagaon Dock Shipbuilders** has been granted "**Navratna**" status by the Department of Public Enterprises. It is now the **18th PSU** in the country to receive this status.
- ◆ A Navratna company can undertake investments worth up to Rs. 1,000 crores, without needing approval from the central government.
- ◆ It is also allowed to form Joint Ventures, and alliances and establish subsidiaries abroad. Some notable Navratnas are Engineers India, CONCOR, Bharat Electronics, Hindustan Aeronautics, RCF, NALCO, NMDC, RVNL, IRCON and IREDA.

## 58. Union Territory of Ladakh achieves full functional Literacy ULLAS

- ◆ **Ladakh has become the first administrative unit to achieve full functional literacy under the ULLAS-Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram** (New India Literacy Program).
- ◆ Lieutenant Governor Dr. BD Mishra made this announcement during a celebration at Sindhu Sanskritik Kendra in Leh.

## 59. Tata Sons to Build ₹650 Crore 'Museum of Temples' in Ayodhya

- ◆ The **Uttar Pradesh Cabinet** has approved **Tata Sons'** proposal to build a '**museum of temples' in Ayodhya**, a project worth Rs 650 crore to be funded through Tata's corporate social responsibility fund.
- ◆ Additionally, the state cabinet has also sanctioned Rs 100 crore for further development works in Ayodhya and endorsed the initiation of helicopter services in Lucknow, Prayagraj, and Kapilvastu.

## 60. DRDO hands over Medium Range-Microwave Obscurant Chaff Rocket to Indian Navy

- ◆ The **Medium Range-Microwave Obscurant Chaff Rocket (MR-MOCR)** developed by the **Jodhpur Laboratory of the Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)** was formally handed over to the **Indian Navy** in New Delhi.
- ◆ The Medium Range-Microwave Obscurant Chaff Rocket (MR-MOCR) developed by the DRDO will enhance the Indian Navy's defensive capability.

## 61. MicrobioTx launches India's first Hyper-Personalised Probiotic

- ◆ The BESS, with a capacity of 254 MWh will enable storing solar energy during low-demand periods and discharging when the demand peaks.
- ◆ **MicrobioTx**, a Bengaluru-based gut health startup, introduced Personal Probiotics, **India's first prebiotic and probiotic blend handcrafted based on individual gut profile, and GutChat**, a free gut health-focused chatbot for gut health enthusiasts.
- ◆ Personal probiotics are hand-crafted based on the results of a unique, patent-protected and clinically proven gut microbiome test.

## 62. Bioplastic Park to be set up in UP Lakhimpur Kheri district

- ◆ The **Uttar Pradesh government** has decided to set up a bioplastic park in the state to deal with **the problem of environmental pollution caused by the petroleum derivative based plastic products in the state.**

- ♦ The bioplastic park to be developed on 1000 hectares of land will be constructed in Kumbhi village, Gola Gokarnnath tehsil, Lakhimpur Kheri district.
- ♦ The project will be developed with an estimated cost of Rs 2000 crore.
- ♦ The state government has made the Uttar Pradesh Expressways Industrial Development Authority (UPEIDA) the nodal agency for the development of the bioplastic park.

### 63. MoE launches nationwide campaign on Tobacco Free Educational Institutions

- ♦ The Ministry of Education (MoE) under the **National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP)** has initiated a nationwide campaign focused on **Tobacco Free Educational Institutions (ToFEI)**.
- ♦ Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education has developed a “ToFEI Implementation Manual” for schools and launched it on World No Tobacco Day (WNTD) which was observed on 31st May, 2024.

### 64. Central Railway installs first-ever Floating Solar Plant in Nashik Lake

- ♦ In a first for the Indian Railways, the **Central Railway (CR)** has installed a **floating solar power plant of 10MWp capacity in the Igatpuri Lake in Nashik, Maharashtra**.
- ♦ Stepping towards its ultimate goal of zero carbon emission by 2030, the CR has already commissioned 12.05 MWp (MegaWatt peak) solar plants on railway stations' rooftops and buildings, adding 4 MWp last year.

### 65. Deputy NSA Vikram Misri to be new Foreign Secretary

- ♦ **Deputy National Security Advisor Vikram Misri** will take charge as the **Foreign Secretary on July 15**.
- ♦ Mr. Misri, who is a former Indian ambassador to China, will succeed current Foreign Secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra.

### 1. Ruchira Kamboj, India's first woman Permanent Representative to UN, retires

- ♦ India's first woman Permanent Representative to the United Nations, **Ruchira Kamboj** retired after 35 years of service, during which she **served as Indian envoy in Bhutan, South Africa and UNESCO**.
- ♦ Kamboj, who was the All India women's topper of the 1987 Civil Services batch and the topper of the 1987 Foreign Service batch, formally assumed the position of Permanent Representative/ Ambassador of India to New York, on August 2, 2022.

### 2. Netherlands emerges as India's 3rd largest export destination in 2023-24

- ♦ The **Netherlands** has emerged as **India's third largest export destination after the US and UAE during 2023-24**, even as the country's merchandise shipments dipped by over 3 per cent, according to the commerce ministry data.
- ♦ The main commodities which registered healthy exports growth in the Netherlands include petroleum products, electrical goods, chemicals and pharma.
- ♦ India's trade surplus with the Netherlands has increased to USD 17.4 billion in the last fiscal from USD 13 billion in 2022-23.

3. **Russian cosmonaut becomes 1st person to spend 1,000 cumulative days in space**
  - ◆ A Russian cosmonaut became the **first person to spend a cumulative 1,000 days in space**.
  - ◆ Oleg Kononenko, 59, reached the record while on his current mission aboard the International Space Station (ISS).
  - ◆ **Kononenko's current mission to the ISS began September 15, 2023**, and is planned to **end September 23, 2024**, which will bring in his total number of days spent in orbit to 1,110.
  - ◆ This is not the first record set by Kononenko. In February 2024, he surpassed the record of 878 days set by his colleague Gennady Padalka for longest amount of time in space.
4. **Pakistan, Panama, Somalia, Greece elected as UNSC non-permanent members**
  - ◆ **Pakistan, Somalia, Denmark, Greece and Panama** were elected as **non- permanent members of the UN Security Council** for a two-year term beginning 2025.
  - ◆ The five members were elected by a secret ballot in the UN General Assembly for a 2-year term starting on January 1, 2025, until December 31, 2026.
  - ◆ In the two seats for African and Asia-Pacific States, Somalia got 179 votes and Pakistan 182.
5. **India launches Biopharmaceutical Alliance with US, Japan, & South Korea**
  - ◆ **India, South Korea, Japan, the US, and the European Union** has launched an **alliance to put joint efforts to build a resilient supply chain** in the biopharmaceutical sector.
  - ◆ The announcement was made at the inaugural meeting of the Biopharmaceutical Alliance, held in San Diego, California, during the Bio International Convention 2024, the world's largest biopharmaceutical exhibition.
6. **Portugal to use golden visa scheme to help migrants**
  - ◆ Portugal to adapt its **golden visa scheme** to allow wealthy foreigners seeking residency rights to **invest in affordable housing for locals or accommodation for migrants**.
  - ◆ The scheme - called a "solidarity visa" - would complement an existing programme, which since 2012 has offered non-EU nationals who invest in Portugal the right to live in the country.
7. **2025 to be International Year of Quantum Science and Technology: UN**
  - ◆ The **United Nations General Assembly** has declared **2025 the International Year of Quantum Science and Technology**.
  - ◆ The 193-member United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution to this effect on 7 June 2024. Earlier, the United Nations had declared 2025 as the International Year of Cooperatives, International Year of Peace and Trust and International Year of Glacier Preservation.
8. **Armenia to leave Russia-led security bloc**
  - ◆ Armenia will leave a Russia-led security bloc, Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan confirmed for the first time, accusing members of the Collective Security Treaty Organisation of having planned a war against his country with Azerbaijan.
  - ◆ The CSTO, headquartered in Moscow, also includes Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Belarus.
9. **Kathmandu to host International Tourism Fair**
  - ◆ **Kathmandu, Nepal** will host an **international tourism fair** aimed at **promoting global tourism, sustainable development, and cultural exchange**.

- ◆ The event beginning 15 June will feature tourism entrepreneurs from 16 countries.
- ◆ Countries participating in the fair include Nepal, India, Korea, Taiwan, Singapore, the Maldives, the USA, the Netherlands, Sri Lanka, China, Thailand, Dubai, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Malaysia, and Bhutan.

## 10. Ukraine launches World's first Unmanned Systems Forces

- ◆ **Ukraine** has established the **world's first stand-alone military branch solely dedicated to unmanned systems**, known as the **Unmanned Systems Forces (USF)**.
- ◆ The USF was officially launched by the Ukrainian Armed Forces and the Ministry of Defence (MoD) in Kyiv, Ukraine.

## 11. 4,300 millionaires may leave India this year: Henley Private Wealth Migration Report 2024

- ◆ The **Henley Private Wealth Migration Report 2024** has revealed that India is set to experience a **significant net loss of 4,300 millionaires this year**.
- ◆ While this represents a decrease from the 5,100 who left in 2023, India remains one of the top countries for high-net-worth individual (HNWI) departures globally.
- ◆ The United Arab Emirates continues to be a favored destination for Indian millionaires. The UAE is expected to attract a record net inflow of 6,700 wealthy migrants in 2024, bolstered by its zero-income tax policy, golden visa programs, luxurious lifestyle, and strategic location.
- ◆ Other top destinations for migrating millionaires include the United States, Singapore, Canada, and Australia.

## 12. Paraguay becomes 100th member of International Solar Alliance

- ◆ **Paraguay** has become the **100th country to join the International Solar Alliance (ISA) as a full member**.
- ◆ The South American nation officially handed over its Instrument of Ratification to the ISA in New Delhi.
- ◆ The ISA, co-founded by India and France during the 2015 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP21) in Paris, aims to promote solar energy deployment worldwide.

## 13. Turkey removed from Money Laundering Grey List

- ◆ **Turkey** has been removed from the **Financial Action Task Force (FATF) 'grey list'** after recent **evaluations of the country's progress on money laundering and terrorist financing**.
- ◆ Turkey was placed on the FATF grey list in 2021 due to concerns about money laundering and terrorist financing in the country.

## Chapter 14: Banking & Financial

### 1. India's fiscal deficit in FY24 improved to 5.6% of GDP: Govt data

- ◆ **India's fiscal deficit stood at Rs 16.54 lakh crore in FY24 as against the budgetary target of Rs 17.86 lakh crore**. With this, the fiscal gap has reached 95.3 per cent of the budgetary target, data from the Comptroller General of Accounts showed.
- ◆ The central government's fiscal deficit stood at 5.6 per cent of GDP in FY24, below the revised estimate of 5.8 per cent.
- ◆ The centre's net tax receipts for FY24 were higher than projected at Rs 23.27 lakh crore,

and 100.1 per cent of the year's target.

2. **RBI imposes monetary penalty on SBM Bank (India)**
  - ◆ **The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty of Rs 88.70 lakh on SBM Bank (India) for non-compliance with certain regulatory norms.**
3. **Canara Bank gives approval to dilute 14.50% stake in insurance unit**
  - ◆ **Canara Bank has granted an approval for initiating the process of diluting its 14.50 per cent stake in its subsidiary Canara HSBC Life Insurance Company Ltd.**
  - ◆ The bank has accorded approval for initiating the process of diluting 14.50 per cent stake of the Bank in its subsidiary Canara HSBC Life Insurance by listing the company in Stock Exchanges (BSE/NSE) through initial public offer (IPO).
4. **Axis Bank and Mastercard Introduce NFC Soundbox**
  - ◆ **Axis Bank has partnered with Mastercard to launch NFC Soundbox.**
  - ◆ The new soundbox will act as an all-in-one solution that will allow the users to accept Bharat QR, UPI, Tap & Pay and Tap + Pin payments.
  - ◆ This device aligns with the Bank's asset lite strategy to provide products/solutions of superior quality at an affordable price.
5. **GST collection rises 10% to Rs 1.73 lakh crore in May**
  - ◆ **The gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue for the month of May 2024 stood at ₹1.73 lakh crore.**
  - ◆ In the month of May, 2024, the Central Government settled ₹38,519 crore to CGST and ₹32,733 crore to SGST from the net IGST collected of ₹67,204 crore.
  - ◆ This translates to a total revenue of ₹70,928 crore for CGST and ₹72,999 crore for SGST in May, 2024, after regular settlement.
6. **Adani One launches two variants of co-branded credit cards with ICICI Bank**
  - ◆ **Adani One**, the digital platform of the Adani Group, and **ICICI Bank** has launched **two variants of co-branded credit cards** in collaboration with card network Visa.
  - ◆ Available in two variants – **Adani One ICICI Bank Signature Credit Card** and **Adani One ICICI Bank Platinum Credit Card** – the credit cards will offer a reward programme to its customers.
  - ◆ Cardholders can get up to 7 per cent Adani reward points on spends within the Adani Group ecosystem.
  - ◆ This includes services such as the Adani One app, which can be used for booking flights, hotels, trains, buses, and cabs, along with spends across Adani-managed airports, Adani CNG pumps, Adani Electricity bills, and train bookings.
7. **SBI joins the Rs 8-trillion m-cap league; eyes \$100 billion m-cap**
  - ◆ **The State Bank of India (SBI) has become the first public sector bank and the seventh Indian company to cross the Rs 8 trillion market capitalisation (m-cap).**
  - ◆ HDFC Bank and ICICI Bank are the only other lenders with m-cap of over Rs 8 trillion.

8. **PNB Board approves 10% stake dilution in Canara HSBC Life Insurance via IPO**
  - ◆ Punjab National Bank's (PNB) Board has approved the initiation of process for divesting 10 per cent shareholding in its associate company Canara HSBC Life Insurance through an initial public offering (IPO) route.
  - ◆ Currently, PNB holds 23 per cent stake in Canara HSBC Life Insurance.
  - ◆ Currently, Canara Bank has a 51 per cent stake in the life insurer, while HSBC has a 26 per cent stake in the joint venture.
  
9. **SEBI mulls raising limit for basic service demat account to Rs 10 lakh**
  - ◆ Capital markets regulator SEBI proposed to enhance the threshold for the basic service demat account (BSDA) to Rs 10 lakh from the current Rs 2 lakh in a bid to boost the participation of retail investors in the securities market.
  
10. **IOB opens an exclusive branch for start-ups in Chennai**
  - ◆ Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) has inaugurated a new, exclusive branch on Anna Salai (Mount Road) in Chennai, dedicated entirely to support start-ups.
  - ◆ This initiative aims to provide robust financial services and comprehensive support to budding entrepreneurs and emerging enterprises.
  
11. **SBI General Insurance withdraws Arogya Plus policy with effect from Oct 5**
  - ◆ Private general insurer, SBI General Insurance Company has announced the withdrawal of its Arogya Plus policy with effect from October 5, 2024.
  - ◆ As per the regulatory requirement, insurance companies must give 90 days' advance intimation to their customers before withdrawing a policy.
  - ◆ Policyholders holding the Arogya Plus policy will be given an option to migrate to a comprehensive health insurance policy like Super Health Insurance or to any other individual health insurance product available with the general insurer, including the Standard Product.
  
12. **RBI keeps Repo Rate unchanged for 8th consecutive time at 6.5%**
  - ◆ The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to keep the repo rate unchanged at 6.5%.
  - ◆ The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has voted by a 4:2 majority to keep the policy repo rate unchanged at 6.5% for eight consecutive times.
  - ◆ The MPC had last changed rates in February 2023.
  - ◆ The MPC has revised its GDP growth forecast upwards from the earlier 7% estimate to 7.2% for the financial year 2024-2025. It has also decided to remain focused on withdrawal of accommodation to ensure that inflation does not accelerate, while supporting growth.
  - ◆ The second bi-monthly Monetary Policy Committee meeting of fiscal year 2024-25 was held on June 5 to 7, 2024. The next meeting of the MPC is scheduled for 6-8 August 2024.
  
13. **Moody's maintains stable outlooks on three Indian public sector banks**
  - ◆ Moody's Ratings (Moody's) affirmed the Baa3 ratings on three Indian public sector banks - Bank of Baroda (BOB), Canara Bank, and Punjab National Bank (PNB).
  - ◆ The rating agency maintained stable outlooks on the long-term ratings of all three banks.

- ◆ Moody's also believes that India's strong operating environment will continue to support their credit fundamentals over the next 12-18 months.
- ◆ BOB's, Canara's and PNB's NPL ratios respectively declined to 2.9 per cent, 4.2 per cent and 5.7 per cent as of 31 March 2024 from 3.8 per cent, 5.4 per cent and 8.7 per cent a year earlier, supported by lower bad loans (or slippage) as well as stronger recoveries and higher write-offs.

#### 14. RBI permits automatic replenishment of UPI Lite wallet

- ◆ **The Reserve Bank of India** has **proposed a facility to allow customers to automatically replenish their UPI Lite** wallets to promote small-value digital payments.
- ◆ Currently, the UPI Lite has a daily limit of ₹2,000, while the upper limit for a single payment is ₹500.
- ◆ UPI Lite is a simplified version of the Unified Payments Interface (UPI). It acts as an on-device wallet for small-value transactions.

#### 15. SBI launches 'SME Digital Business Loans

- ◆ **State Bank of India (SBI)** has launched '**SME Digital Business Loans**', offering end-to-end sanction turnaround time of up to 45 minutes for SMEs (small and medium enterprises).
- ◆ SME Digital Business Loans leverages technology and an ecosystem of APIs (application programming interface) to streamline the lending process.

#### 16. ICICI Pru Life activates WhatsApp, Digital Rupee for premium payment

- ◆ **ICICI Prudential Life Insurance** has begun accepting premium payments through the RBI's Central Bank Digital Currency, popularly known as digital rupee.
- ◆ The company will also provide customers the option to make premium payments through WhatsApp.

#### 17. India's Wholesale Prices Accelerate to 15-Month High of 2.61% in May

- ◆ **India's wholesale inflation**, measured by the **wholesale price index (WPI)**, **surged to a 15-month high of 2.61% in May from 1.26% in April**, driven by an adverse base effect and a sharp increase in food prices.
- ◆ The inflation rate for food items reached 9.82%, contrasting with -3.61% in May 2023.

- ◆ The Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation in April was at 4.83 percent.

## 19. Industrial production declines to a three-month low of 5% in April

- ◆ **The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) in India** slowed to **5 per cent in April**, a three-month low, as against 5.4 per cent in March, according to Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI).
- ◆ The IIP growth rate was recorded at 4.6 per cent in April 2023.

## 20. HDFC Bank raises FD rates by 20 basis points

- ◆ The largest private sector lender **HDFC Bank** has **hiked retail fixed deposit rates by upto 20 bps** across various buckets with effect from June 10.
- ◆ The move comes even if the Reserve Bank of India decided to keep the policy repo rate unchanged in the June review of monetary policy.

## 21. FIU imposes over Rs 1.66 crore fine on Axis Bank for failing to detect fraud NSG account

- ◆ The **Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU)** has **fined Axis Bank over Rs 1.66 crore** for failure to detect and report suspicious transactions involving a fraudulent account created in the name of the NSG counter-terrorist force.
- ◆ The agency's order under the PMLA found Axis Bank employees complicit in a large-scale fraud.

## 22. Indian Bank organizes MSME credit camp

- ◆ **Indian Bank** has organized a **credit camp for the MSME sector in Chennai**.
- ◆ The event was chaired by MD & CEO of the Bank SL Jain. During the camp, 440+ sanction tickets amounting to over Rs 500.00 crore (Approx.) were distributed to MSME customers.

## 23. ESAF SFB to discontinue business correspondent services of ESMACO

- ◆ **ESAF Small Finance Bank (ESAF SFB)** has **decided to discontinue the services of business correspondent ESAF Swasraya Multi State Agro Co- operative Society Limited (ESMACO)** to reduce concentration risks and absorb its 5,000 plus employees on the rolls of the lender.

## 24. ICICI Prudential Life offers Lifetime 15% Discount for Women on iProtect Smart Term Plan

- ◆ **ICICI Prudential Life Insurance** offered a **15% lifetime discount** for women on all premiums for its best-selling term insurance product, iProtect Smart.
- ◆ Furthermore, salaried/working women will be eligible for an additional 15% off the first year's payment, allowing them to create financial stability for themselves and their loved ones.

## 25. Federal Bank launches RuPay Wave credit card

- 26. Universal Sampo settles ₹8 crore claims under Ayushman Bharat in 4 months**
- ◆ **Universal Sampo General Insurance Company** has provided cashless claims approval of ₹8.03 crore for over 8,170 hospital admissions under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana in the Union Territory Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.
- 27. S&P Global Ratings retains India's growth forecast for FY25 at 6.8%**
- ◆ **The S&P Global Ratings** retained its growth forecast for India at **6.8 per cent for FY25**, citing high interest rates and lower fiscal boost tempering demand in the non-agricultural sectors.
  - ◆ **For FY26 and FY27**, S&P projected India's economy to **grow at 6.9 per cent and 7 per cent, respectively.**

- 30. India received \$120 billion remittances in 2023: World Bank**
- ◆ According to the **World Bank report**, **India has received USD 120 billion remittances in 2023.**
  - ◆ China (USD 50 billion), the Philippines (USD 39 billion), and Pakistan (USD 27 billion) figure in top five countries list of remittances recipients.
- 31. SBI raises ₹10,000 crore through infra bonds**
- ◆ State Bank of India (SBI) has raised ₹10,000 crore at a coupon rate of 7.36 per cent through its fifth infrastructure bond issuance.
  - ◆ The issue attracted an overwhelming response from investors, with bids in P[excess of ₹19,884 crore, and was oversubscribed by around four times against the base issue size of ₹5,000 crore.

- ◆ Initially, he started with a throw of 78.32 meters, then improved to 80.59 meters in the third attempt.

## 5. India bag 7 medals at Taiwan Athletics Open

- ◆ In the **Taiwan Athletics Open 2024**, the Indian contingent concluded the campaign with a remarkable medal haul, **bagging seven medals including three golds, three silvers and one bronze medal**.
- ◆ In women's Long Jump, Nayana James clinched the gold medal, registering the best jump of 6.43 metres. Sumire Hata of Japan won the silver.
- ◆ In Men's 800 metres, India's Ankesh Choudhary bagged the gold, clocking 1 minute 50.63 seconds, while compatriot Somnath Chouhan won the silver medal clocking 1 minute 50.88 seconds. In Men's pole vault, Dev Meena won the silver medal.

- ◆ India's **Tanvi Sharma bagged the women's singles title** at the **Bonn International Badminton Tournament** in Germany.
- ◆ The young Indian shuttler defeated Wang Pei Yu of Taiwan in straight sets, 21- 19, 22-20.

## 7. Dinesh Karthik announces retirement from all forms of cricket

- ◆ Days after announcing retirement from the Indian Premier League tournament, ace Indian wicket-keeper batter **Dinesh Karthik announced retirement from all formats of cricket**.
- ◆ He last played for Royal Challengers Bengaluru in the IPL 2024 Eliminator on 22 May.

## 8. Real Madrid's Historic 15th Champions League Title

- ◆ **Real Madrid etched their name in the history books once again by securing a record-extending 15th UEFA Champions League title**.

- ◆ **NASA had picked SpaceX** to build a vessel to carry the **International Space Station** back through Earth's atmosphere and on to a final resting place in the Pacific Ocean after **it is retired in 2030**.
- ◆ Elon Musk's company has been awarded a contract with a potential value of **US\$843 million** to develop and deliver the spaceship, dubbed the US Deorbit Vehicle.



- ◆ Weighing 430,000 kilograms (950,000) pounds, the ISS is by far the largest single structure ever built in space.
